

## Outcomes of Using PAMF

- PAMF will unite resource managers, researchers, and other stakeholders around a common management problem (non-native *Phragmites*)
- Participants will get help with treatments and help others in the Great Lakes basin at the same time
- PAMF will promote cooperative, transparent decision making to reduce uncertainty regarding the effectiveness of several management approaches
- PAMF is a cost-and-time-efficient way to address a large, regional-scale problem

## Services Provided by PAMF

- Free data analysis that provides treatment guidance based on best known management practices
- A standardized monitoring protocol that is scalable to different management areas
- Development of site-specific Best Management Practices (BMPs) that can be shared across the Great Lakes basin, and throughout North America
- A free user-driven web hub to access customized *Phragmites*-related information from anywhere, at any time
