



A Guide to PAMF Participant Training

To help accommodate so many *Phragmites* managers across the Great Lakes Basin, we have created an online *Phragmites* Adaptive Management Framework (PAMF) participant training that can be accessed anytime by visiting <https://www.greatlakesphragmites.net/pamf/training/>.

New Participants

Reviewing the resources in all 6 training modules will ensure that you are ready to collect high-quality data as a PAMF participant.

Start your training by clicking on *Module 1-introduction* and make your way down to *Module 6 – Additional Resources*. *Module 1-Introduction* will be open when you arrive to the page. To open a new module, simply click the gray “+” button on the right side of the module. The modules are made to be reviewed sequentially, as the information will build off previous modules.

Start off each module by watching the videos. If you are unable to access the videos, transcripts of each are available as a PDF and can be found below the video. Next, review what you have learned by testing yourself with the *Knowledge Checks*! Finally, go through the additional resources posted at the end of the module. These resources hold a lot of information and are great guides to aid you in your PAMF participation.

Learn at your own pace! The modules can be accessed at any time, as many times as you need. Reviewing modules 1 through 5 should take approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes. Module 6 has additional resources included a full recording of the May 2020 training session, which can be watched in place of the videos in modules 1-5.

Be sure to check out the additional resources at the end of each module.
